	Writing – Students will be honing their skills writing persuasive texts and utilising the 'Seven	
	Steps to Writing Success' method. They will learn about the writing process including	
	brainstorming, planning, drafting, editing and publishing across the school year.	
	Spelling – Students will continue to learn through the Soundwaves spelling program in	
	2020. Each week, students will learn a new phoneme (basic unit of sound) and the	
	associated grapheme (letter selections to represent the sounds) choices. Students engage	
	in whole class interactive lessons, small group work and online games as part of this
