Welcome back to a busy and exciting term!

Term 3 holds many new and creative experiences for our Kinders. We are very keen to dive into our 'Ocean Explorers', integrated unit. As part of this unit, each class will learn about our local rivers, beaches, investigate water pollution, the effect rubbish has on waterways, and oceans, research a marine creature and care for a class pet.

Curriculum Overview Term 3



During Term 3, Kindergarten will be focusing on our integrated unit, 'Ocean Explorers'. Students will develop an understanding of local rivers and beaches and use geographical tools to explore features of oceans. They will explore living things and the environment at the beach and identify the basic needs of living things.

Maths: Students will be exploring money, dividing objects into equal groups, representing and interpreting data using graphs and measuring the capacity of different containers.

English: Our L3 (Language, Learning and Literacy) program continues in all Kinder classrooms during the morning sessions, providing rich literary experiences to assist all children to become successful readers and writers. Reading and writing activities are differentiated to ensure we are meeting the learning needs of each student. Groupings within our L3 classroom are flexible to reflect the children's varying levels of progress in all elements of English.

You can find more information about online payments on our website. Although voluntary, school fees are a vital part of our budget each year and pay for essential items in classrooms. At WRPS our voluntary fees are \$55 per student, \$100 for two children or \$130 for a family of 3 or more children.
