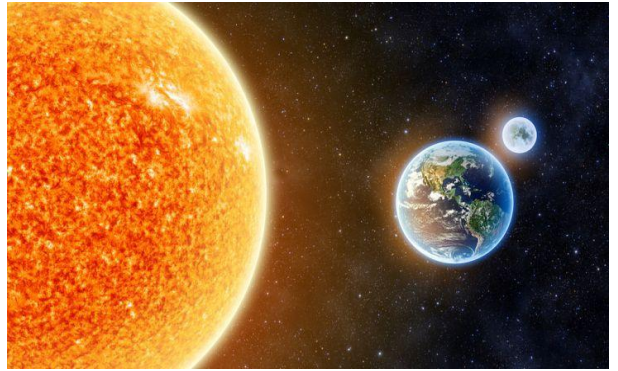




3H Newsletter - Term 4, 2020

Curriculum 'Snapshot' of Term 4

Our Place in Space Integrated Unit:

Science – describing how the relationships between the sun and the Earth cause regular changes on Earth and investigating how objects can affect other objects without touching them.

English:

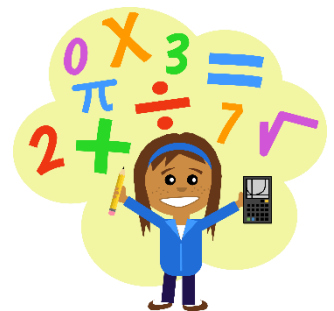
Reading – Consolidating understanding of comprehension strategies and applying these to understand a variety of scientific and factual texts relating to 'Our Place in Space'

Writing – Descriptive, informative, imaginative and procedural texts



Speaking and Listening – Students will need to apply their communication skills in a variety of ways to present their scientific explorations and discoveries to the class throughout the term.

Mathematics:

- Whole Number – Recognise, model, represent and order numbers to at least tens of thousands
- Addition and Subtraction – solve problems involving purchases and the calculation of change required to the nearest 5 cents
- Chance – Describe possible everyday events and order their chances of occurring
- Multiplication and Division – Use mental strategies to divide a two-digit number by a one-digit number where there is no remainder
- Position – Use simple scales, legends and directions to interpret information contained in basic maps
- Patterns and Algebra – Solve word problems by using number sentences involving multiplication and division where there is no remainder.

<p>School Fees</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● This is a reminder that school fees can still be paid through our online payment portal. This is a secure payment page hosted by Westpac. ● Log onto our school site at:- www.wyrallahrd-p.schools.nsw.edu.au ● Click on "Make a Payment" and follow the prompts to make a payment via Visa or MasterCard. You can find more information about online payments on our website. ● Although voluntary, school fees are a vital part of our budget each year and pay for essential items in classrooms.
