Prime Minister – Henry

Roles:

- Ensure all ministers are on track with roles
- Liaises with Principal, P&C and canteen helpers so that all are aware of Parliamentary activities

Roles:

Minister for Education – Cohen and Mia

Roles:

- Organises whole school assemblies
- Monitors Premier's Reading Challenge
- Hand out Win Bins at morning assembly
- Organises collection of Win Bins boxes every fortnight
- Hand out and ensure collection of merit awards on even weeks.

Minister for Social Justice, Health & Safety – Henry, Yael, Alana, Flynn

Roles:

- Hand out Win Bins for positive student behaviour in the playground
- Develop school spirit and fair go attitude
- Cooperate with teachers to ensure all children are being treated fairly
- Each fortnight collects lost property and distributes items with names to students. Remainder have tags removed and are washed.
- Monitors the playground for unsafe behaviour/equipment and report all problems
- Reminds children about wearing school hats
- Promote school health campaigns including Crunch and Sip and No Hat No Play

Minister for Sport – Emilie

Roles:

- oversees and delegate sporting responsibilities (Sport House Captains and Vice Captains rotate through the Terms to complete the responsibilities)
- Meets with teachers to see what equipment is required for sport and fitness. Sets up and returns equipment to shed

- Maintains neat storage of equipment in classrooms and shed. Cleans up sport shed at least once per term, ensures all balls are pumped up and damaged equipment fixed or removed
- Writes list of equipment needed and hands to Miss Eakin
- Ensures all children respect rules of games

Roles:

- Organising committee of NAIDOC celebrations
- Work with Mrs Roberts on indigenous peer tutoring program
- Coordinate Welcome / Acknowledgement of Country for school events
- Help with Aboriginal Welcome BBQ
- Teacher contact: Mrs Brewer-Charles, Mrs Golding and Miss Beaumont

Minister for Technology – Archer

Roles:

- Works with Mr Wilton on technology issues
- Cleans the keyboards and screens on all computers in school
- Coordinate computer time (lunch)
- Ensures nobody eats food while at the computer
- Checks that all students know computer rules
- Assists students with log on and access to computers
- Ensures that all students have a fair turn on computers
- Opens Computer Lab and turns computers on in the morning
- Locks Computer Lab and turns off computers in the afternoon

Minister for Transport – Freya and Lachlan

Roles:

- Set up bus and car pick up lines
- Organises student monitor for bus lines
- Reports to principal / teacher if students misbehave on numerous occasions
- Hand out Winbins for students demonstrating positive behaviour in bus lines

Minister for Communication – Nathan

Roles:

- Reads newsletter and requests teachers to speak to children about topic OR makes announcements at assemblies
- Distributes paper copy of newsletter to any families who request it
- Ensures posters for *Positive Behaviour for Learning* are all in good condition
- Communicate the weekly PBL focus to the students and staff
- Keeps and records minutes from parliament meetings

Minister for the Environment – Anouk

Roles:

- Reminder at assembly about the cleanliness of school; encourage everyone to pick up papers
- Organise Clean Up Australia Day
- Checks each classroom once per week for special mention at assembly (electricity is off, tidiness, etc)
- Ensures lights are not on when not required
- Provides staff and students with information regarding coloured bins within the school
- Set up and maintain collection of food scraps for worm farm
- Make and display roster for morning watering of school garden
- Sets dates and promotes “Waste Free Lunch” days each term
- Ensure birdbaths have water every day

Minister for Junior School – Paul and Connor

Roles:

- Organises games in playground for K-2 students
- Organises activities such as colouring in / dance comps
- Help with visiting preschools
- Deliver Kinder lunch orders to the teacher on duty
- Teacher contact: Mrs Perring, Mrs Bennett and Miss Budd
- SRC Committee Members: Yael, Heath, Freyja

Minister for Community Services & Treasurer – Ashtynn

Roles:

- Plan one activity each term for charity fundraising eg: UNICEF Cup, Crazy Hair, etc for the school and outside organisations
- Write message for Newsletter – Date, time and type of activity
- Collect and count money raised

- Report to children at assembly about money raised
- Teacher contact: Mrs Golding, Mrs Hall and Mrs Connolly

Food and Beverage Minister – Heath

Roles:

- Thank parents on canteen roster each week
- Line children up outside canteen
- Encourage children to say thank you
- Help younger students with orders
- Promote healthy eating campaigns
- Deliver Early Stage 1 and Stage 1 lunches to the teachers on duty.
