This is a rare opportunity to have a say on the way federal funding is distributed to schools. David will be presenting facts and information on how we – individually and as a committee- can make a difference. Did you know under the current system each student in the private system receives \$3 - \$5 000 on average more than our own children in the public system...sound fair? Two thirds of all students attend public schools yet receive only one third of the funding...sound fair? Come along and see what can be done to get a fairer funding formula for our children.
