## STUDENT REQUIREMENTS FOR 2011

- **Early Stage 1 and Stage 1 – Years K, 1 & 2**

As the school provides equipment (including lead and coloured pencils) children do not need personal equipment. However, \$15 will be required for a Maths Text Book.

- **Stage 2 – Years 3 & 4**
