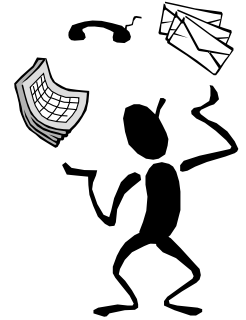

SKATEBOARDS

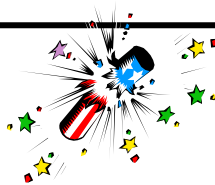
Students are not to ride or bring skateboards to school. These are to be used after school and on weekends under family supervision.
