

WYRALLAH ROAD PUBLIC SCHOOL P&C
MUSIC LESSON SUBSIDY PROGRAM

Applications are being invited for the WRPS P&C Music Lesson Subsidy Program. This program has been made available through the generous support of the WRPS P&C, to support the accessibility of instrumental instruction to Stage 2 students. Subsidies are intended for students who, without financial help, could not make a sustained commitment to taking music lessons and applications are open to both new and continuing students.

In 2020, subsidies will be valued at \$80 per term for the period of one school year (\$280 yearly total). This amount covers approximately 50% of the tuition fees. Families will be required to pay the balance of tuition fees (up to \$80 per term). Failure to make co-contributions by due dates will result in a student's removal from the program.

Applicants must demonstrate their financial need and commitment to the WRPS Instrumental Program, by completing the application form and Contract of Commitment. Applications will be assessed by a small panel of executive staff who will also take into consideration student attendance, and effort and application across all areas of the school. All information provided on the application form will be held in confidence and permanently destroyed after the application is processed.

Please be sure to fill out form completely and return it to Wyrallah Road Public School no later than Friday 6 December, 2019. Completion of application is not a guarantee that a subsidy will be awarded.
