



Year 5 and 6 Stationery Requirements 2021

Book Covers

To ensure student books are kept in quality condition and to make life easier for parents, Year 3, 4, 5 and 6 teachers will be arranging for all student exercise books to be covered at school in 2020. If your child is in Year 4 this year or new to the school or you didn't purchase book covers this year, now is your chance! To cover the cost of the book covers we ask that parents pay \$7 per student – this will need to be paid in **CASH** to your child's current classroom teacher **at the beginning of 2021**. Purchased book covers will be provided to students when payment has been received. If covers have already been purchased, they will be stored ready for them to use again in 2021.

This is a list of the items needed by your child to begin the new school year. The list has been carefully prepared by teachers with specific items listed to best support the educational needs of your child. Specific brands have been suggested, however an alternative brand is fine.

Your child may bring ONE medium-sized pencil case (30cm x 15 cm max) of your choosing to school, along with the following requirements.
