

Expression of Interest for High school online form (how to guide for parents)

Step 1. Go to the Wyrallah Road Public School website <https://wyrallahrd-p.schools.nsw.gov.au/>
Click on the Enrolment tab at the top of the tool bar.

Step 2. Scroll down until you see the bold heading in the text **Moving to high school**.

Step 3. A new NSW Education Department screen will appear with the heading **Moving to high school** with the subheading **For Year 6 students attending Wyrallah Road Public School**.

Step 4. If you would like your child to attend a government high school in 2025 click on the blue tab titled **Start expression of interest.** This tab will only be available to access from 6-28 March 2024.

Moving into year 7 in a NSW Government school in 2023
In NSW Government schools, moving from primary school to high school is called the 'Year 6 to Year 7 transition' or simply 'high school transition'.
If you would like your child to attend a government high school in 2023, you will need to complete an expression of interest for Year 6 to 7 transition. The expression of interest lets you indicate which school(s) you would like your child to attend in Year 7. After you submit this expression of interest and it has been assessed, your child will be offered a place at a government high school.

Need help filling the expression of interest?
The expression of interest form should be completed in English. If you require an interpreter to assist you please call the Telephone Interpreter Service on 131 450 and ask for an interpreter in your language. This service will be free of charge to you. You can also contact your child's primary school for assistance.

Apply for Year 7 placement in a NSW Government school
The online expression of interest process makes it easier and faster to see your child's options for high school and nominate your preferences for next year.

Step 5. Enter the student's home address. Once the address field has been completed this links to the high school that your child is zoned to attend. You need to enter the correct address to proceed even if you do not want to send your child to the high school that is listed. There is a page to enter your preferred high school later in the process. Click **Proceed** at the bottom of the page.

Online Year 6 to 7 Transition Process for Primary, Central and Community Schools

This form lets you indicate which school you would like your child to attend in Year 7. After your expression of interest is processed, your child will be offered a place at a government high school.

This form must be completed in English. You will need your child's residential address, their basic details and the contact details for one parent/carer.

If you require an interpreter to assist you please call 131 450 and ask for an interpreter in your language. This service will be free of charge to you.

Step 7. Enter in your email address or click to use the Service NSW account. This is so you can receive correspondence from the high schools.

Step 8. You will then be sent a verification code to your email address or your Service NSW account. You will need to enter this code into the field.

Step 9. Enter the student details as requested. Click **Proceed** and move to the next section.

Step 10. High School Options - Requesting your child be placed in their non-zoned school (out of area school)

At the top of this page is a reminder to parents of the local high school that the student is zoned for. However, underneath this section is where you click yes if you wish your child to be placed at any other government school besides your local high school, this is the Out of Area school (the school they are not zoned for however wish to attend). Click *No* if you are happy for the student to attend the zoned high school as displayed.
